

CLC House Rules

The buildings and grounds of Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church (CLC) are an extension of a house of worship and should be treated as such. The following are those items, which seem to take time and notice from an otherwise orderly and active CLC community. These rules apply to any and all persons, and to all of the buildings and grounds of the CLC community, at all times.

1. **No violence**, physical, or psychological intimidation, bullying, or cyber bullying; harassment, or discrimination of any kind. **No** alcohol, drug use or paraphernalia. Abusive behavior of any kind, to others, or to self, is **not** permitted.
2. **No** stealing, or misappropriation: borrowing without prior consent. No foul language. Illegal activity of any kind is **not** permitted.
3. Inappropriate sexual conduct, paraphernalia, or pornography is **not** permitted in any of the common or public areas of CLC.
4. **No** weapons of any kind are allowed anywhere within the CLC community, without proper authorization.
5. **No Smoking.**
6. Reckless activities and/or behaviors are **not** permitted on CLC property, (i.e.: running, skating, roller blading in or on the buildings or on any stairs, handrails, or ramps; rough play, inappropriate ball playing indoors, etc.).
7. During school hours, all outer doors in the Community Center are to be **closed** at all times. If you will be in the building during school hours, please phone ahead and inform the school staff you will be in the building, or announce yourself to the school staff upon entering the building. Also, please inform the school staff when you will be departing the building. The playground equipment, and the indoor play gym equipment and mats are the property of CLC Preschool, and are **not** for public use.
8. Report any unsafe conditions, or issues with the buildings, (cracks, leaks, no heat or water, etc.), to the Property Committee immediately, if you are unsure, report it.
9. All buildings, and grounds are part of the CLC community, and are here for everyone, you must **share** them; always leave them better then the way you found them.
10. We recycle; please place all items in the appropriate receptacle.
11. Check all doors, windows, and bathrooms prior to leaving, and turn off non-security lights.
12. You will show the proper respect for the buildings, their mission, and to every individual and group that utilize them. Speak in a professional, positive, and polite manner at all times, to all people, in all situations.
13. Any issues between individuals or groups, should first be attempted to be resolved between the individuals, and/or groups prior to escalation.
14. If issues cannot be resolved between the individual and/or group, they may be brought before the Church Council for presentation and resolution. The individual or group may also present possible resolutions to Church Council.
15. The decisions made by Church Council are final.
